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KTA awards two construction contracts in December

Wichita, KS – The Kansas Turnpike Authority announces bids have been approved and contracts awarded on two upcoming Turnpike construction projects.

Project #5739 – A two-year project to widen and re-deck the two Arkansas River Bridges at MM 44.325 I-35/Turnpike was awarded to A.M. Cohron & Son, Atlantic, IA for \$7,188,168.35. The letting took place on December 8 in Topeka.

Project #5879 – A two-year project to reconstruct the two Bridges at MM 157.013 and remove the two Bridges at MM 157.143 I-335/Turnpike was awarded to King Construction, Hesston, KS for \$4,484,732.66. The letting took place on December 8 in Topeka.
