Arkansas River Bridge on I-35/Turnpike nearing completion

WICHITA, Kan.— Construction on the northbound bridge over the Arkansas River located at mile marker 44 on I-35/KTA, in south Wichita, is nearing completion.

Traffic impacts, starting November 16 include:

- Traffic will be transitioned to their respective northbound or southbound bridges.
- The inside left lanes, in both directions, will be closed for additional median work.
- Speeds will remain reduced to 60 mph through the construction zone until construction is completed.

The project is expected to be substantially completed in early December, weather permitting. This construction was part of a two-year project to widen and re-deck the Arkansas River Bridges. Learn more about the project [here](#).
