

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that the Kansas Turnpike Authority (KTA) is requesting sealed proposals for furnishing all labor and materials and performing all work in accordance with the Plans and Specifications and other Contract Documents, for the project known as **East Kellogg (US-54/400) – Greenwich and I-35 (KTA) Interchanges, KTA Contract No. 5872**, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

**TYPE OF WORK:** This work will consist of constructing ramps on the KTA (I-35) from milepost 50.9 to milepost 52.3 and 6-lane freeway on Kellogg Avenue between Greenwich and K-96. Work includes Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) Project No. 54-87 KA-2389-01, and City of Wichita Projects 472-85032 (Paving), 468-85099 (Sewer), and 448-90689 (Water).

Plans are not directly available through the Kansas Turnpike Authority. The Project Manual, Special Provisions, Plans, and Geotechnical Report in pdf format can be picked up, and plans purchased at Quick Print, 217 N. **PRE-QUALIFICATION.** Bids will only be accepted from Contractors that are pre-qualified by the Kansas Department of Transportation.

**MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE.** A mandatory pre-bid conference for this project is scheduled for 10:00 AM on Tuesday, July 19, 2016 in the Kansas Room, Terrace Level, Farm Credit Building, 245 North Waco, Wichita, Kansas 67202. Contractors wishing to bid on this project are required to attend the pre-bid conference.

**SEALED PROPOSALS.** Sealed proposals will be accepted during normal business hours (8-5) at the Kansas Turnpike Authority Wichita Headquarters Office, Attn: Glen Scott, at 9401 East Kellogg, Wichita, Kansas 67207 until Friday, August 5, 2016, at 2:00 PM. All bids must be made on the required bid form or exact copy thereof. All blank spaces for bid prices must be filled in, in ink, or typewritten, except as provided for Alternates A and B, and the bid form must be fully completed and executed when submitted. Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing on the outside the name of the bidder, his address, and the name of the project for which the bid is submitted. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed to KTA as specified herein. The following items are required to be **signed and** submitted with the bid submittal:

1. **Bid Proposal.**
2. **Bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of bid and made payable to the Kansas Turnpike Authority as guarantee that the bidder will enter into a contract and give a performance bond as required if awarded the contract.**
3. **All addenda signature pages.**

**BID OPENING.** Proposals will be opened and read publicly at 2:15 PM, Friday, August 5, 2016, at the Kansas Turnpike Authority Wichita Maintenance Building - Sign Shop at 9401 E Kellogg, Wichita, Kansas. Facsimile bids will not be accepted.

The award of each contract shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Standard Specifications of the Kansas Department of Transportation, edition of 2015, and will be based upon the summation of the products of the unit prices and the approximate quantities.

The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity therein and determine which is the lowest responsible bid most suitable to the Authority.
