Contracts awarded on two spring construction projects

WICHITA, Kan.— The Kansas Turnpike Authority announces bids have been approved and contracts awarded on two upcoming Turnpike construction projects. Work on both projects will begin in March 2020 and are scheduled for completion in December, weather permitting.

Contract #7506 – To redeck and raise an overhead bridge at MM 155.5, which carries K-31 over I-335/KTA, was awarded to Wildcat Construction Co., Inc. & Subsidiaries, Wichita, KS, for \$1,464,445.39.

Contract #7557 - Reinforced concrete box drainage improvements on I-335/KTA at MM 151.5 and MM 153.8, was awarded to King's Construction, Oskaloosa, KS, for \$1,936,481.
